The Journeyman Welder will be required to assist the Design Department with insight and knowledge of superior manufacturing methods, perform random maintenance on returned products to be refurbished or re-worked to customer specifications, and have strong knowledge and skill in operating all metalworking machinery. Additionally, the Journeyman Welder will be required to read and understand production drawings, blueprints, work orders and other written instructions.
